Application area

Gelomat is added to all Le Tonkinois paints to give the paint a matte or satin sheen. Gelomat is homogenized by simply mixing it with the paint before applying the coating color.

Processing

Processing

You can achieve different levels of mattness, ranging from matte, to silk matte to silk gloss. You will obtain a uniform effect if you always mix paint or varnish with the same quantity of Gelomat, taking into account the proportions mentioned below:

Matt: mix Gelomat and varnish in equal amounts.

Silk matt: mix 1/3 Gelomat with 2/3 varnish.

Silk gloss: Gelomat and varnish in a ratio of one to three.

Ensure good ventilation during application.

Usage

Depending on the desired matting, see mixing ratio.

Drying time

According to the product to be matted.
